


Necrotizing Enterocolitis (NEC) is a major cost driver in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) & is among highest per-case cost for Medicaid & commercial insurance.5



Breast milk significantly reduces the incidence of NEC and is the only treatment to do so



One Day Absences Twice as Often for Formula-Fed compared with Breast Milk Fed Babies⁹




